The following Lusophone or Lusophone-related events have been cancelled or postponed on account of the 2020 Covid-19 pandemic.

- REBRAC - 4th annual Brazilian Cultural Studies conference, scheduled for 20-21 March, University of Oxford, with 25 speakers from UK, Brazil, Portugal, Germany, Denmark and Ireland.
- 'From Analogue to Digital: Film Criticism in the Spanish and Portuguese-speaking World' MHRA-sponsored one-day conference, scheduled for 3 April 2020, University of Leeds. 4 out of 8 papers on Portugal/Brazil and film criticism
- TROPO (Portuguese Language Teachers) event, José Peixoto Coelho de Sousa, 'Materiais didáticos com base em canções no Ensino de Português na perspectiva do letramento literomusical' scheduled for 14 March 2020 at University of Liverpool.
- 'Queering Luso-Afro-Brazilian Studies', scheduled for 5-6 May 2020 at the University of Leeds.
- AHGB (Association of Hispanists of Great Britain and Ireland) Annual Conference, scheduled for 30 March - 1 April 2020, University College Dublin. 4 papers on Lusophone topics.
- SLAS (Society for Latin American Studies) conference, scheduled for 17-18 April 2020 in Amsterdam.
